

RESOLUTION #R22-10

SURPLUS PROPERTY DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, the Williamsburg Area Transit Authority ("WATA") has surplus property that had met surpassed its useful life and is no longer of operational value; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors must authorize disposal of surplus property with an estimated market value greater than \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended disposal of a 2009 Supreme Trolley that was placed into service in August 2009 and has surpassed its useful life of 5 years or 150,000 miles; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended disposal of a Compressed Natural Gas compressor that was placed into service in 2010 and has surpassed its useful life of 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Williamsburg Area Transit Authority authorizes the disposal of the surplus property in accordance with WATA's Asset Management Policy and applicable law.
