ADOPTION OF DRAFT WILLIAMSBURG AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY
TITLE VI PROGRAM – FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2021-2024

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA) is a recipient of Federal revenues and is required to meet federal regulatory requirements for the Title VI, established by 49 C.F.R. part 21.7; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requested that WATA provide a Title VI Program update every three years that ensures that no person or group of persons on the basis of race, color, or national origin is subjected to discrimination in the level and quality of transportation services and benefits and that steps are taken to ensure that persons with Limited English Proficiency are provided these rights; and

WHEREAS, WATA developed an updated Title VI Plan based on best practices that meet FTA Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Williamsburg Area Transit Authority that the Revised Williamsburg Area Transit Authority Title VI Plan and Procedures FY 2019-2021 presented is hereby adopted.
