WILLIAMSBURG, Virginia (March 31, 2020) - Pursuant to Section 2.2-3707(C) of the Code of Virginia, Williamsburg Area Transit Authority Board of Directors will hold a Special Meeting 9 a.m. Thursday, April 2, 2020 at the main WATA facility, 7239 Pocahontas Trail, Williamsburg, VA 23185.

Topics for consideration include:

- A modification to the service contract with The College of William and Mary;
- An amendment of the FY2020 Budget to address emergency funding;
- An amendment to the Purchase Agreement with The Colonial Williamsburg Foundation; and
- the status of current operations and possible changes, if any.

The public will not be able to attend the meeting in person due to state COVID-19 guidelines against public gatherings of more than 10 people.
